LEADERS OF THE SOVIET UNION SOCIETY OF PEDIATRICIANS



Alexander KISEL
(19.03.1859–31.08.1938),
(chairman 1927–1938, Moscow)

He has made significant contribution for the clinic and prevention of tuberculosis, rheumatism, malaria, and rickets. He was the head of the therapeutic department of Moscow Olginsky children's hospital for 24 years, from 1910 to 1935 — professor and director of children's clinic of the higher women's courses (now Pirogov Russian National Research Medical University).



Georgy SPERANSKY
(19.02.1873–14.01.1969),
(chairman 1938–1962, Moscow)

One of the founders of Russian neonatology. His researches in the field of nutrition and digestive disorders, bronchopulmonary pathology, sepsis have played significant role in managing of infant mortality. He was the director of the GNIOMM which was created due to his initiative (now NMRCC of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation).



Julia DOMBROVSKAYA
(11.12.1891–26.12.1976),
(chairman 1962–1974, Moscow)

Her works on the etiology, clinical features, pathogenesis and treatment of childhood pneumonia were very crucial. She has been the head of the children's diseases department in the first Moscow Medical Institute (now Sechenov First Moscow State Medical University) from 1951 to 1970.



Mitrofan STUDENIKIN
(02.12.1923–07.07.2013),
(chairman 1974–1991, Moscow)

His scientific works were devoted to vascular dystonias, neonatology, nutrition of children of different age, allergic diseases, cystic fibrosis, liver, bile, kidneys and blood pathologies, and social aspects of children's healthcare. He was the head of the Research Institute of Pediatrics of the USSR Academy of Medical Sciences (now NMRCC of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation) from 1961 to 2006.

LEADERS OF RUSSIAN SOCIETY OF PEDIATRICIANS



Alexander TUR
(15.09.1894–24.07.1974),
(chairman 1959–1974, Saint Petersburg)

He headed Nutrition Council of Leningrad Pediatric Medical Institute (now St. Petersburg State Pediatric Medical University) in besieged Leningrad. Together with his students he has developed 18 recipes for soybean milk substitutes, malt and other products. He is the founder of such sections of Russian pediatrics as neonatology, dietetics, pediatric hematology and endocrinology.



Valentina BISYARINA
(24.07.1912–19.08.1997),
(chairman 1974–1987, Omsk)

Outstanding scientist and clinician, well known public figure, she was a deputy of Supreme Soviet of the USSR, headed Omsk regional peace protection Committee. She has actively studied such pathologies of Siberia and Altai regions as opisthorchosis, brucellosis, tuberculosis, endemic goitre since pre-war times. She has continued these studies after World War II as well as studied issues of pediatric cardiorheumatology.



Andrey MAZURIN
(06.10.1923–15.03.2001),
(chairman 1987–1994, Moscow)

He is one of the founders of the Soviet pediatric gastroenterology. The first specialized gastroenterology department, Moscow Gastroenterological and endoscopic centers were founded with his direct involvement. He headed the children's diseases propedeutics department in 2nd Medical Institute (now Pirogov Russian National Research Medical University) in 1967–1989s.


THE CREATION OF THE UNION OF PEDIATRICIANS OF RUSSIA

The First Deputy Minister of Health Alexander Baranov ending his duties has shown his intuition and has created the International Foundation for mother and child health in 1991, after the breakup of the Soviet Union. This newly created organization had to play an incredibly important role in supporting the pediatric service in the novel Russia and helping the professional societies of pediatricians to carry out their activities in improving the training of pediatricians through holding congresses, conferences, and symposia.

The major event in the life of the pediatric community was the Foundation Conference of the Union of Pediatricians of Russia in 1994. The Union became legal successor of the pediatricians' societies of USSR and the Russian Federation. At the same time, the Foundation held the Russian Assembly "Maternal and child health", then it has started holding annual congresses and conferences of pediatricians of Russia dedicated to the most topical problems of child health protection. Concurrently, regional branches of the Fund and the Union of Pediatricians of Russia started to appear.

The concern of the pediatric community about the growing negative events in the protection of children health and life was raised on the Congress of Pediatricians of Russia in April 1995. Upon an initiative of Alexander Baranov, the Congress has prepared appeal to the President, the Government, and the Parliament of Russia, as well as to the Russian entrepreneurs. This attracted the attention of the government and the civil society to the problems of children, it became the basis for the federal programs “Children of Russia”, “National Strategy for Children in 2012–2017”, and later the President Decree “On Proclaiming the Decade of Childhood (2018–2027) in the Russian Federation”.

The International Foundation for mother and child health fulfilled its main task. It has allowed the Union of Pediatricians of Russia to grow strong during this country’s transition period, and the pediatric community to survive in decade of social disturbances. The Union has begun to conduct activities independently since the beginning of 2000.

Alexander Baranov remained the permanent head of the professional organization of pediatricians in the country for 23 years, and then he was elected the Honorary President of the Union of Pediatricians of Russia in 2017.

Alexander BARANOV

He is famous pediatrician, combining the features of scientist, teacher, clinician, and organizer of healthcare. His major scientific researches are devoted to the fundamental problems of children growth and development, implementation of new technologies for the diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the digestive system, prevention of socially significant diseases in children and adolescents, and reduction of infant mortality in the country. He was the ideologist of creation and the head of the Scientific Center for Children's Health of the Russian Academy of Medical Sciences (now National Medical Research Center for Children's Health of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation) from 1998 to 2018. He is the head of the children's diseases department in Moscow Medical Academy named after I.M. Sechenov from 1992 to 2016, now he is the professor of the department, adviser of the head of Pediatric and Child Health Research Institute in Central Clinical Hospital of the Russian Academy of Sciences of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education, leading external expert pediatrician of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation, academician of the RAS.




Leyla NAMAZOVA-BARANOVA
(date of birth July 18, 1963)
(President from 2017
to the present day, Moscow)

She is one of the founders of pediatric allergology and clinical immunology. Her basic scientific researches are devoted to topical problems of pediatrics, preventive vaccination, public health and rehabilitation. She was deputy director for scientific work in the Scientific Center for Children's Health of the Russian Academy of Medical Sciences (now National Medical Research Center for Children's Health of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation) from 2006 to 2018. She is the head of pediatrics department on pediatric faculty of Pirogov Russian National Research Medical University of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation since 2010, the head of Pediatric and Child Health Research Institute in Central Clinical Hospital of the Russian Academy of Sciences of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education since 2019, leading external expert pediatrician on preventive medicine of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation, academician of the RAS.



The President is the sole executive body of the Union. The President is elected by the Conference for a term of six years and can be elected for a new term.

Ivan Troitsky



Scientific papers of the I Congress of the International Pediatric Association, Paris, October 7-9, 1912

Historical notes:

- Ivan Troitsky, Russian professor of pediatrics, head of the childhood diseases department in Kharkiv University, conducts active correspondence 1907-1911 years with well-known Russian and Western European pediatricians and public figures about the establishment of international association of pediatricians and holding the congress.
- The first Charter of the International Pediatric Association was adopted on July 28, 1910. The main goals of its creation were as well formulated: «the unity of colleagues living in different countries working on children's diseases». I. Troitsky was the author of the draft Charter.
- Leading author of the adopted draft Charter has begun organizing the Russian Committee of the International Pediatric Association. It included A. Kisel, N. Korsakov, V. Zhukovsky and other famous Russian pediatricians.
- The I International Congress of Pediatricians was held on October 7-9, 1912, thanks to the long-term preparation of I. Troitsky and his direct assistants (N. Korsakov, V. Zhukovsky, V. Hutinel, etc.).

Thus, we can state the significant contribution of Russian pediatricians in the creation of the International Pediatric Association and the holding of the I International Congress of Pediatricians.

The Union of Pediatricians of Russia continues to cooperate with the International Pediatric Association and is its active member so far.



Participation in 9th European Congress of pediatricians — Europaedics-2019, Dublin, Ireland

The European Congress of Pediatricians always unites pediatricians and specialists in the field of child health not only from Europe, but also from all other continents.



Many speakers have delivered their welcoming remarks on the Europaedics-2019: Minister of Health of Ireland Simon Harris, chairman of the Europaedics Scientific and Organizing Committee, professor Hilary Hoy, dean of the pediatric department of the Royal College of Physicians of Ireland dr. Ellen Crashell, President of EPA/UNEPSA and the Union of Pediatricians of Russia Leyla Namazova-Baranova (with report «Vision and mission of Pediatric community of Europe»).



President of EPA/UNEPSA and the Union of Pediatricians of Russia Leyla Namazova-Baranova was awarded the title of Honorary Member of the pediatric department of the Royal College of Physicians of Ireland during the opening ceremony of the congress.



The Europaediatrics-2019 was attended by about 2,000 delegates, leading pediatrics experts from more than 75 countries. The third largest national delegation was Russian one (80 participants), next to host country of Ireland and the neighboring UK. Members of the Union of Pediatricians of Russia were active participants during the Congress; they have performed numerous oral and poster presentations, chaired several sections and conducted numerous discussions presenting Russian experience.



The 10th anniversary Europaediatrics-2020 has been postponed due to epidemiological situation caused by the new coronavirus infection, and it is planned to be held in Zagreb, Croatia, in October 2021.

THE UNION OF PEDIATRICIANS OF RUSSIA

Collaboration with European Young Pediatricians Association EURYPA

The first General Assembly of the European Young Pediatricians Association EURYPA was held in Dublin, Ireland, in June 2019 during the 9th European Congress of Pediatricians Europaediatrics-2019. Young scientists representing the youth wing of the Union of Pediatricians of Russia also took part in it.



The goal of EURYPA (established in 2015) is to improve the health of European children by uniting young pediatricians and pediatric residents to participate in educational, scientific and research projects, as well as promoting equal pediatric education in all European countries.





The EURYPAsession was held at the 5th Congress of Young Pediatricians in Istanbul, Turkey, December 2019. Pediatric residency programs in different countries were discussed during this session.

Young Russian pediatricians, members of the Union of Pediatricians of Russia, have prepared their presentations and taken active part in the discussion.

EURYPAPresident Ruya Meric (Turkey) have participated in the XXII Congress of Pediatricians of Russia «Actual Problems of Pediatrics» in February 2020 via the invitation of the youth branch of the Union of Pediatricians of Russia. She made a report on the topic «Pediatric residents training on the European continent. Similarities and differences».





CLINICAL GUIDELINES

The Union of Pediatricians of Russia on behalf of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation has developed 110 clinical guidelines on children's healthcare in the period from 2013 to 2018.

The Union of Pediatricians of Russia in collaboration with other medical professional non-profit organizations continues to develop and update clinical guidelines on the most relevant nosologies (including orphan diseases) since 2019 as part of the implementation of the Federal Law №489 from December 25, 2018, and according to the orders of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation.

There are clinical guidelines approved earlier, they are valid until 01.01.2022 (80 documents are available for free on the Union website).

By now, 7 clinical guidelines have already been approved by the Scientific and Practical Council of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation, and by the Union of Pediatricians of Russia and professional organizations/co-authors.

Moreover, another 15 clinical guidelines were sent to the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation (in collaboration with specialized professional associations). 9 drafts of clinical guidelines were posted on association's website, and the work continues on updating 44 more documents.


